Essential qualification for the post of Professor in the Departments.

- (i) An eminent scholar with Ph. D. qualification in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/College, and or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidate for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and course, and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) as laid down in the UGC Regulation, 2010 in Appendix III.

SI. No. A. 5: Essential Qualification for the Post of Professor in Computer Science & Engineering:

- (i) Ph. D degree with First class at Bachelor's or Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering & Technology: and experience of ten years in teaching, research and or industry, out of which at least five years at the level of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor or equivalent.

OR

- (ii) First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering & Technology with significant professional work which can be recognized as equivalent to a Ph. D Degree in appropriate branch of Engineering & Technology; and industrial/professional experience of ten years, out of which at least five years at senior level of Assistant Professor/Associate Professor.

- (iii) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) as laid down in the UGC Regulation, 2010 in Appendix III.

Essential Qualification for the post of Associate Professor:

- (i) Good academic record with a Ph. D degree in concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- (ii) Minimum 8 years of experience of teaching at the University, College level and or research in University/National level institutions excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degree and a minimum of 5 publications as books and or research/policy papers.

- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation as designing of new courses curricula and or outstanding performing achievement in the field of specialization - As per UGC Regulation 2010.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) as laid down in the UGC Regulation, 2010 in Appendix III.

SI.No. B.11: Essential Qualification for the post of Associate Professor in the Department of Computer Science and Engineering.

- (i) A Ph. D degree with First class at Bachelor's or Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering & Tech. and experience of 8 years in teaching, research and or industry at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent grade, excluding period spent on obtaining the research degree.

OR

- (ii) In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following shall constitute as essential:
 - (a) First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering & Technology: and
 - (b) Significant professional work which can be recognized as equivalent to a Ph. D Degree in appropriate branch of Engineering & Technology and industrial/professional experience of 8 years in a position equivalent to the level of Assistant Professor. Provided that the recognition for significant professional shall be valid only if the same is recommended unanimously by a 3-Member Committee of Experts appointed by the Vice-Chancellor of the University.

SI.No. B.13: Essential Qualification for the post of Associate Professor in the Department of Management.

- (i) Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent in a point scale wherever grading system is followed in Master's Degree in Business Management/Administration in a relevant management related discipline or first class in 2 years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU/recognized by the AICTE/UGC.

OR

First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant/Cost and Works Accountant/Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

- (ii) Ph. D or fellow of Indian Institute of Management (IIM) or of an Institute recognize by AICTE and declared equivalent by the AIU.
- (iii) A minimum of 8 years experience of teaching/industry/research/professional at managerial level excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degree.

OR

- (iv) In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following requirements shall constitute as essential requirements:
 - (a) Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management/Administration in a relevant management related discipline or first class in 3 years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU/recognized by AICTE/UGC.

OR

First class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant/Cost and Works Accountant/ Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

- (b) A minimum of 10 years experience of teaching industry/research/profession, out of which 5 years must be at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent excluding the period spent for obtaining research degree. The candidate should have professional work experience, which is significant and

can be recognized at national/international level as equivalent to Ph. D and 10 years managerial experience in industry/profession of which at least 5 years should be at the level comparable to that of Lecturer/Assistant Professor.

Education Qualification for the post Assistant Professor

- (I) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an accredited Indian/Foreign University.
- (II) Fulfilling the above qualification, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test(NET) for Lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET, SET. Candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph. D Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph. D Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in University/Colleges/Institution.

Important Instructions

1. NET/SLET/SET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professors in Universities/Colleges/Institutions. Provided however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph. D Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph. D Degree) Regulation, 2009, shall be exempt from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
2. Candidates in service should submit application through proper channel or enclose, **NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE**, from their present employer. However, an advance copy may be sent directly, application received after stipulated date or **incomplete will not be entertained and shall be rejected; no further correspondence will be made in this regard.**
3. **For all the posts, the eligibility criteria shall be in accordance with the latest UGC Regulations.**
4. Mere submission of application/satisfying the eligibility criteria does not entail the candidate to be called for interview. University reserves the right to shortlist the applications and call for interview. The University also reserves the right to reject the candidature of the candidate at any stage of recruitment/selection process if anything found false, tampered, fabricated or suppression of any information while registering the application and submitting the certificates/testimonials.

5. If there is any change in the address after submission of application, the candidates should in his/her own interest arrange with the post office concerned for redirection of the communication from old to new address.
6. **Separate application is required to be submitted for each Post.**
7. Against specific reserved quota, only candidates of that particular quota will be considered. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level for the SC/ST category for all posts and persons with Disabilities (PWD) in appointment as Assistant Professor: please note-(i) Caste certificates from competent authority for SC & ST candidates in the prescribed format have to be produced. PWD candidates claiming the benefits of reservations should submit a copy of Medical Certification as specified as specified in the Disabilities Act of 1995 in support of their disability. (ii) if the candidates wish to be considered against a specific community quota and tick the community column according, their application will be rejected unless proof of community in the prescribed format is enclosed: and(iii) any subsequent representation for change or community status will not be entertained under any circumstances.
8. Reservation is available for Persons with Disabilities under section 33 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Right & full Participation), Act, 1995. As reservation for physically challenged candidates is on horizontal basis, the selection candidates will be placed in the appropriate category (viz. SC/ST/OBC/PED/UR).
9. Applicants for the reserved post of OBC are required to submit a certificate regarding his/her "**OBC Status and belongingness to NO CREAMY LAYER**" from the appropriate competent authority.
10. The application form should be maintained neat and clean and signed by the candidate in his own handwriting only.
11. Candidate should clearly mention the correspondence address with pine code carefully as applicable otherwise application can be rejected.
12. Application once made will not be allowed to be withdrawn and fees once paid will **not be refunded** on any account nor can it be held in serve for any other purpose.
13. **The University reserves the right to postpone/cancel this recruitment exercise for any/all the posts.**
14. Those candidates who will attend the interview for the post of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor and or equivalent no TA/DA will be given.
15. **Canvassing in favour of candidature both direct and indirect is strictly prohibited. Violation of the code of conduct will be treated as misconduct and will be brought to the notice of Selection Committee. The University reserve the right to cancel candidature of such candidates at any point of time if found in canvassing in any form.**
16. **How to apply:** Application fees of Rs. 400/- must be submitted along with the application form. The candidates SC/ST/PWD are exempted from the application fees, however, an amount of Rs. 100/- should be paid as postal expenses only.
